







 - · Surface mines and quarries

DIR Daily Report 2.22.19 - DOSH

• February 21, DOSH Long Beach district office was notified by XYZ Mobile Park of a fatality in Torrance. A maintenance worker fell while descending a ladder sustaining back and head injuries and was transported to hospital where he succumbed to his injuries on February 9. DOSH is investigating.



DIR Daily Report 2.22.19 - DOSH

February 21, DOSH Modesto district office was notified by the San Joaquin County Coroner's office of a fatality in Stockton. An owner of ABC Park Apartments fell from a ladder sustaining head injuries on February 18 and was transported to hospitals where he was pronounced brain dead-pulmonary death on February 21.

Falls from elevation More than 12 times per year requires "permanent elevated work location"

"Frequently"

Falls from elevation

§3270. Access General.

(b) Every permanent elevated work location, where there is machinery, equipment, or material which is customarily operated or frequently repaired, serviced, adjusted, or otherwise handled and every other permanent elevated work location, shall be provided with a safe platform or maintenance runway.

Falls from elevation

Article 1. Definitions

§3207. Definitions.

"Frequent. For the purpose of these orders frequent shall mean more than twelve times each year unless specifically stated otherwise in individual orders."

Six citations issued on lockout tag of which 3 were serious

•50% serious is high for Cal OSHA

Routine inspections
 We find procedural
 errors

- Accident investigation...
- •We find no Lock out

Mine Safety Committee

Safety committee shall be organized at each place of employment to which the MSO applies

Mine Safety Committee once every month a safety committee shall make a detailed inspection of all working places, and equipment.
